Culinary Job Training Program Eligibility Criteria

The following is a list of program eligibility requirements for

DC Central Kitchen's Culinary Job Training Program. The applicant must:

1. Be at least 18 years of age
2. Be available to be in class from 8:30am to 4:00pm Monday through Friday
3. Be curious, ready to learn, and willing to do homework.
4. Be interested in a full-time career in food service
5. Have 120 days drug free before the first day of class
6. Be willing to undergo random drug screenings throughout the training.
7. Be either unemployed or underemployed
8. Be able to read, speak, and comprehend English in a fast paced environment
9. Have basic math skills and an adequate reading level for studying a textbook, completing exams and writing job related documents.
10. Have use of all limbs
11. Be able to see well enough to read at 2.5 feet
12. Be able to stand for a minimum of 4 hours
13. Be able to lift 50 pounds
14. Be able to hear in a noisy environment with background noise from a distance of 20 feet
15. High School Diploma OR GED Certificate

Please submit the following documents with your application:

1. A picture identification: driver's license, ID or passport
2. A referral letter from case manager or a letter of support from a sponsor
3. Possess & submit a recent (within the last 6 months) TB PPD Test Results
4. A copy of your social security card or verification of social security number.
5. A police clearance
6. High School Diploma OR GED Certificate
